2. A machine to dispense soda water.

Soda Jerk: Someone, typically young, that works in a soda fountain

Soda Water: A sparkling water produced by adding carbon dioxide, often in the form of bicarbonate of soda, to purified water

Soft Drink: A non-carbonated or carbonated beverage that does not include beverages that contain alcohol.

Vending Machine: A machine from which you can buy small items such as drinks and sweets by putting coins into it.

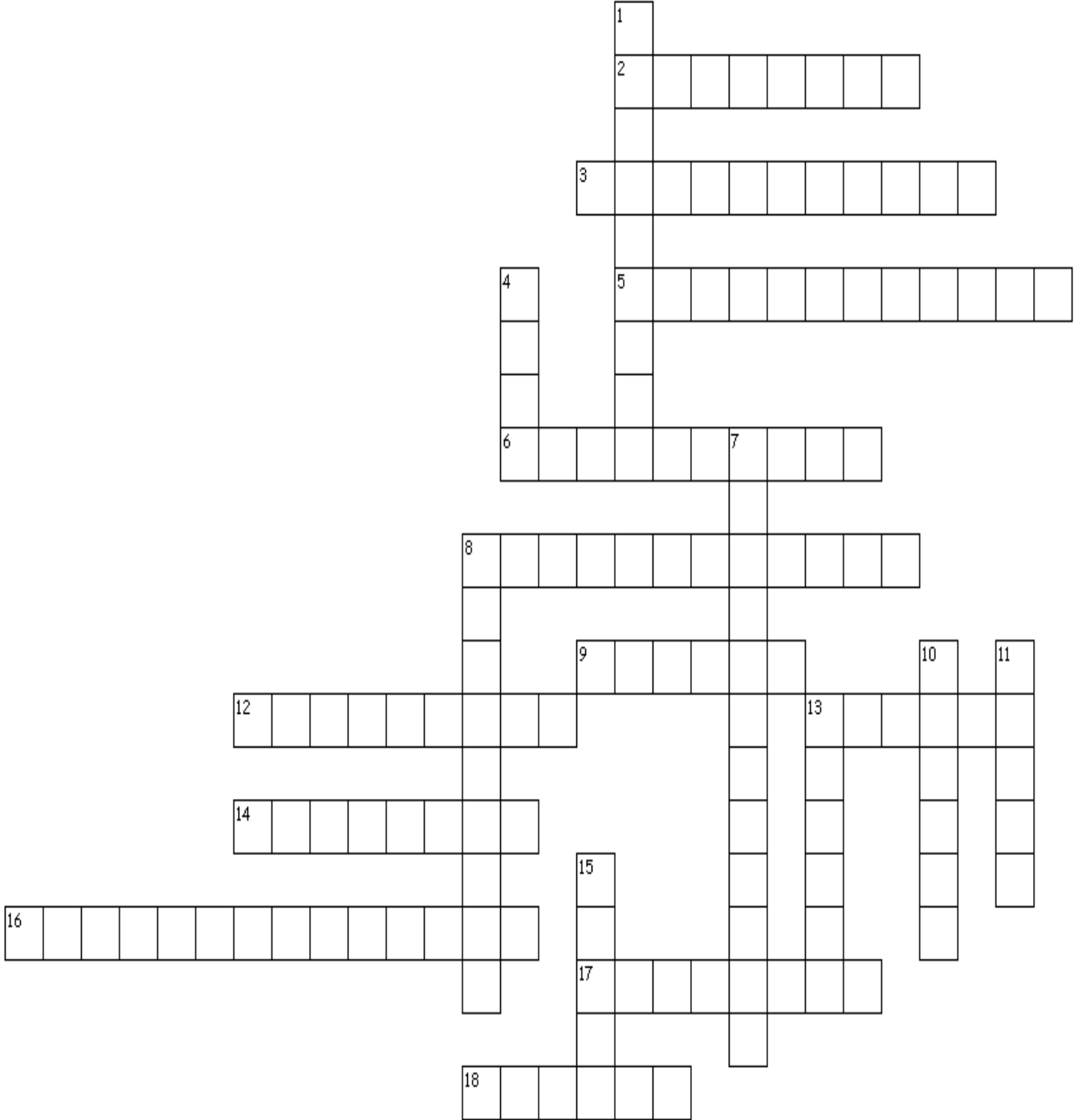
